## HOW DO I MAKE A COMPLAINT ABOUT THE POLICE?



Complaints can be made in one of the following ways:

- In person, by going to a police station and asking to be seen by a supervisory officer.
- Fill in a complaint form at norfolk.police.uk or suffolk.police.uk
- Email psd@norfolk.pnn.police.uk
- Call **101**
- Write a letter with a full account of the incident to;
  Professional Standards Department, Norfolk
  Constabulary, Jubilee House, Falconers Chase,
  Wymondham, NR18 0WW
- Through other agencies such as Citizens Advice Bureau, Solicitors etc. If you need assistance in making a complaint, including language translation services, please go to norfolk.police.uk or suffolk.police.uk for more information.
- You can make a complaint on behalf of someone else, provided you have that person's written consent.
